Math and Science

Graphing calculators are required in all courses. Our guidelines specify that all students should have their own **TI-83, TI-84, or TI-Nspire CX calculator**. The TI-84 is the preferred calculator and has all of the applications that are needed for our courses and standardized tests. Please note that calculators with CAS functionality are prohibited.

Please check to ensure your student has a working calculator before returning to school. The calculator guidelines for the most common standardized tests are below. Please note that a Desmos graphing calculator is now available on the PSAT, SAT, and ACT.
